
Mentorship

- Differentiation career niche


• Strengths:

ASPHO experience

Interim analysis:

- 48% regular meetings
- Positive experience
- Productivity: planning clinical trials, presentation, educational material, job searches
- Barriers: time constraints, lack of frequent communication



SIOP mentorship program

- Aims:
 - To develop and grow YI
 - Opportunity to share research experience
- Cooperation with SLAOP
- Pilot: 10 mentor mentee pairs



SIOP mentorship program

- Contract defining goals
 - Career advice, liaison scientific community/disease committees, research projects
- 3 years
- Meeting frequency > quarterly
- Systematic evaluation

- Increase number of awards
- Award includes:
 - Travel/accomodation annual conference
 - SIOP membership
 - SIOP mentorship program
 - SIOP YI-NET committee member



SIOP young investigators award

- Clinicians/researchers < 40
- Selected on abstract
- Stratified selection:
 - 20% Asia
 - 20% Africa
 - 20% Latin America
 - 10% Oceania
 - 15% North America
 - 15% Europe
